

COUNCIL DECISION (CFSP) 2021/1867
of 22 October 2021
amending Decision 2010/638/CFSP concerning restrictive measures against the Republic of Guinea

THE COUNCIL OF THE EUROPEAN UNION,

Having regard to the Treaty on European Union, and in particular Article 29 thereof,

Having regard to the proposal from the High Representative of the Union for Foreign Affairs and Security Policy,

Whereas:

- (1) On 25 October 2010, the Council adopted Decision 2010/638/CFSP ⁽¹⁾, concerning restrictive measures against the Republic of Guinea.
- (2) On the basis of a review of Decision 2010/638/CFSP, those restrictive measures should be extended until 27 October 2022.
- (3) Decision 2010/638/CFSP should therefore be amended accordingly,

HAS ADOPTED THIS DECISION:

Article 1

Article 8(2) of Decision 2010/638/CFSP is replaced by the following:

‘2. This Decision shall apply until 27 October 2022. It shall be kept under constant review. It shall be renewed or amended, as appropriate, if the Council deems that its objectives have not been met.’

Article 2

This Decision shall enter into force on the day following that of its publication in the *Official Journal of the European Union*.
