Travel exemptions in effect

The Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 1988 (2011) decided on 23 June 2021 to extend the exemption to the travel ban imposed by paragraph 1 (b) of resolution 2255 (2015) for ***Abdul Ghani Baradar Abdul Ahmad Turk*** (TAi.024), ***Sher Mohammad Abbas Stanekzai Padshah Khan*** (TAi.067), ***Zia-Ur-Rahman Madani*** (TAi.102), ***Abdul Salam Hanafi Ali Mardan Qul*** (TAi.027), ***Shahabuddin Delawar*** (TAi.113), ***Abdul Latif Mansur*** (TAi.007), ***Amir Khan Motaqi*** (TAi.026), ***Abdul-Haq Wassiq*** (TAi.082), ***Khairullah Khairkhwah*** (TAi.093), ***Nurullah Nuri*** (TAi.089), ***Fazl Mohammad Mazloom*** (TAi.023), ***Abdul Kabir Mohammad Jan*** (TAi.003), ***Din Mohammad Hanif*** (TAi.043) and ***Noor Mohammad Saqib*** (TAi.110), for a 90-day period beginning on 24 June 2021 and ending on 22 September 2021.

The travel ban exemption is solely for travels required for participation in peace and reconciliation discussions in a range of countries. Individual itineraries will depend on the location of peace discussions. The Committee has also decided to grant a limited asset freeze exemption only for financing exempted travels.
