

COUNCIL DECISION (CFSP) 2023/811**of 13 April 2023****amending Decision 2014/145/CFSP concerning restrictive measures in respect of actions undermining or threatening the territorial integrity, sovereignty and independence of Ukraine**

THE COUNCIL OF THE EUROPEAN UNION,

Having regard to the Treaty on European Union, and in particular Article 29 thereof,

Having regard to the proposal from the High Representative of the Union for Foreign Affairs and Security Policy,

Whereas:

- (1) On 17 March 2014, the Council adopted Decision 2014/145/CFSP ⁽¹⁾.
- (2) On 13 March 2023, the Council adopted Decision (CFSP) 2023/572 ⁽²⁾, which renewed the measures provided for in Decision 2014/145/CFSP for a further six months.
- (3) The Council has received new information concerning certain persons subject to restrictive measures and listed in the Annex to Decision 2014/145/CFSP. On the basis of that information, the entries concerning 35 persons should be updated.
- (4) Decision 2014/145/CFSP should therefore be amended accordingly,

HAS ADOPTED THIS DECISION:

Article 1

The Annex to Decision 2014/145/CFSP is amended as set out in the Annex to this Decision.

Article 2

This Decision shall enter into force on the day following that of its publication in the *Official Journal of the European Union*.
